ZB MED developed the LIVIVO search portal for life sciences to facilitate interdisciplinary research in the fields of medicine, health care, and nutritional, environmental and agricultural sciences. ZB MED is continuously improving LIVIVO to reinforce its status as a one-stop discovery service for life sciences.

Services and features

How to set up your link resolver:

For a lot of institutions, LIVIVO can display a location-specific button that lets your customers check whether items in the list of search results are available locally at your facility. To activate this service, please send an email to livivo@zbmed.de containing the following information:

- ▶ Name of your institution
- ▶ Base URL of link resolver
- ▶ URL of button to be displayed or an alternative short discription
- ▶ IP address range in which the button should be displayed

Search agent

Databases integrated in LIVIVO

LIVIVO performs a simultaneous search of more than 55 million records from over 71 carefully selected specialist databases.

Conducting searches in LIVIVO

Intelligent search technology

LIVIVO incorporates user-friendly semantic search technology. That means it searches for synonyms, different word variations and other contextual aspects in multiple languages, all at the same time.

The system draws on specialist thesauri (MeSH, UMTHESES, AGROVOC) to incorporate synonyms in your search and identify abbreviations.

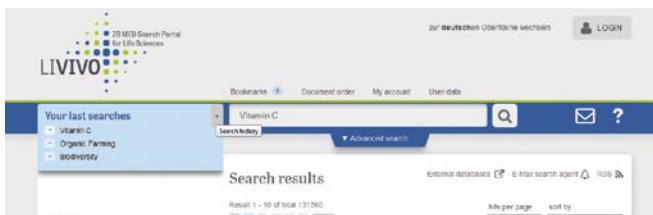
This intelligent search technology automatically searches for different word endings and translates key terms into other languages.

- ▶ No need to use truncation or masking with „?“
- ▶ No need to enter word variations manually
- ▶ To deactivate intelligent search, simply put your search term(s) in quotation marks

The Advanced Search function allows you to combine up to four search fields. You can also use Boolean operators (AND, OR, NOT) in the basic search box.

Search history

The search history shows a list of recent searches in your current session and lets you link together recent searches. The big arrow to the left of the search box takes you back to your last search, and the drop-down list shows you all your recent searches. Click on an item in the list to re-run the search. Click on the plus sign in front of a term to add it to your current query using Boolean operators (AND, OR, NOT).

List of search results

Ranking

LIVIVO automatically sorts your search results by relevance. A number of factors are used to rank each hit, including the date of publication and the frequency and position of the search terms in the document. Advertising has no influence on LIVIVO search rankings.

Accessing documents

Depending on availability there may be up to three different ways of accessing a document in your list of search results. Full text



online, See ZB MED holdings, Order with fees. If no tabs appear under a search result, you can still click Details or More links for information and links to online databases. You may look at single volumes of a series or journal and to any separate volumes that may be available.

Exporting search results using bookmarks

You can save the items as bookmarks and export them via email or as a download to use them in reference management programs (e.g. In HTML or RIS format). Bookmarks are saved to your profile if you are logged in.
