

LIVIVO - Tips for Getting Started

Open a LIVIVO account

Account options

My account

- ▶ Click on **My account** above the search bar.
- ▶ Some items in the menu on the left – Loans, Orders, Reservations, and Fees – are only visible to users who have a fully activated **ZB MED Cologne library card**.
- ▶ Click on **Document delivery** to see documents you have paid for and ordered (not just from ZB MED's holdings).

Renew items

- ▶ Click on the **Renew all items** link
- ▶ This automatically extends the loan period of any items that are eligible for renewal (green = item renewed, red = item cannot be renewed).
- ▶ Items cannot be renewed more than five working days before the return date.
- ▶ Renewals are only possible up until the last day of the loan period.
- ▶ Overdue fines will be payable for any items renewed after this time.

Update my details

- ▶ Click on **My account** above the search bar.
- ▶ Click on Change user data to notify us of changes to your address or email.
- ▶ The other data listed here (e.g. name, different delivery address) is only required for the fee-based document delivery service.

Create an account

1. Go to **www.livivo.de** in your browser.
2. Click on **Login** in the top-right corner.
3. Click on the link lower down the page (**Quick registration for users with a ZB MED Cologne library card**).
4. Enter your library card number and PIN (your eight-digit date of birth) and click **Register**.
5. Confirm your data by clicking **Save user data now** at the bottom of the screen.

You can now log in to LIVIVO with your library card number and PIN and manage your library account.

Three ways to access items

A Full text online

Click this tab to access the full text of the item online. This may be free of charge or subject to restrictions depending on the licence conditions.

- ▶ Green dot: free of charge
- ▶ Yellow dot: free of charge after registering for remote access or on site
- ▶ Red dot: access may require payment of a fee

B See ZB MED holdings

- ▶ This tab indicates that the item is held in ZB MED's stocks. Click on the tab for information on where to find the item (shelf mark, location) and its loan status.
- ▶ Items that are marked as **Available for loan** can be found at the stipulated location and borrowed using the self-service issue machines.
- ▶ Items marked as **Order for loan/Order to use in reading room** can be ordered in one click if you are already logged in. Your item will generally be kept on the collection shelf in the reading room for ten working days and can be borrowed through the self-issue machines by clicking on the link.
- ▶ Items that are currently on loan can be ordered by clicking on **Reservations**. You need to be logged in to do this. As soon as the item is returned, we will let you know by email. The item will be kept for you for ten working days.
- ▶ Please visit our location in Bonn to carry out loans and **reservations** of books from ZB MED Bonn.

C Order with fees

- ▶ **subito**: This delivery service sends orders directly to your home. Click on **Order via subito with fees**
- ▶ **Inter-library loan**: You can order an item that is not held by ZB MED for a fee of €1.50. It will be delivered to ZB MED ready for collection or borrowing.
